Currently, 58.1% of the 34,288 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.4%, renter occupied; and 10.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 33,851 housing units in the area - 61.8% owner occupied, 28.2% renter occupied, and 10.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.57%. Median home value in the area is \$155,793, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.16% annually to \$200,377.
