

Currently, 60.4% of the 16,780 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.2%, renter occupied; and 10.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 16,558 housing units in the area - 62.7% owner occupied, 27.5% renter occupied, and 9.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.59%. Median home value in the area is \$122,165, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.33% annually to \$130,508.
