Currently, 57.7% of the 28,073 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.1%, renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 27,721 housing units in the area - 60.5% owner occupied, 28.9% renter occupied, and 10.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.56%. Median home value in the area is \$135,007, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.02% annually to \$156,686.
